Summary

This entity is the final record of a student's performance in their courses at the end of a semester or school year.

Object Triggering Logic

Action	Business	Rule(S)
--------	----------	-------	----

When transcript records are posted for a student and they have a valid Student School Association for the configured year or when a resync is completed for the school the student is enrolled, all eligible transcript records for all years will send for the Student
Do not send a record if the course is marked as inactive
The course must exist in the ODS for the Course Reference to send as part of this resource. Use the following logic to determine which Course Reference to send:
If the School Number and Course Number on the transcript record are in the configured year ODS, report the Course reference with those numbers
If School Number and Course Number on the transcript record are in the ODS for the configured year but not the school where the student is enrolled, report the course reference with the School and Course Number that matches the School & Course in the ODS
If School Number on the transcript record is in the ODS for the configured year but not the school where the student is enrolled but the Course number matches the school they are enrolled, the course reference will report with the School Number where the student is enrolled
If the School Number on the transcript record is not in the ODS and the course number matches the school where the student is enrolled, the course reference will report where the student is enrolled
If the School Number on the transcript is not in the ODS but the Course Number matches a school where the student is not enrolled, the course reference will report with the school where the course match is found. If there is more than 1 school with that course number, pick the school with the highest schoolID.
If the School Number on the transcript is not in the ODS and the course number does not match any course in the district, a record will not send and will not trigger an error
Do not send a record if the transcript's score is null
Do not send record if the School Exclude check box is checked
Do not send record if the Calendar Exclude check box is checked
When any part of the Natural Key is changed
When any field not part of the Natural Key is changed

Error Message	Possible Causes / How to Fix

400: 'RESOURCE' failed. RESOURCE reference could not be resolved.	A resource that was referenced from a difference resource does not yet exist. Resync the resource being mentioned in the error, then resync the errored resource. Alternatively, the resource being referenced may be incorrect. This can happen with Schools and the Ed-Fi School ID being used as an example. Double check the referenced values being sent are valid.

403: Authorization denied. The claim does not have any established relationships with the requested resource.	The key/secret being used does not have permission to send a record for the resource / referenced resource.
	 Double check your API credentials (key/secret). Sometimes specific keys/secrets cannot report specific resources. The referenced person (student, staff, parent, contact, etc.) has not yet been associated to the key /secret. Resync their "linking" resource (Students Student School Associations, Staffs Staff Education Organization Assignment Associations, etc.) then resync the errored resource. The referenced person (student, staff, parent, contact, etc.) may not exist in the ODS yet. Resync the "person" resource and the "linking" resource (Students Student School Associations, Staffs Staff
404: Failed to delete 'RESOURCE'. Record does not exist.	Education Organization Assignment Associations, etc.) then resync the errored resource. The attempt to delete a specific Ed-Fi record ID in the ODS failed because it did not exist. This error can be ignored. The ID was cleared from the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping Report and will not
409: A natural key conflict occurred when attempting to create a new resource ' RESOURCE' with a duplicate key.	attempt to delete again. The Ed-Fi API has a natural key system alongside a standard REST ID system. This error is often protecting against the erroneous creation of a duplicate record in the API. However, it may also indicate that the natural key requirements of the Ed-Fi API have not been satisfied, and the key needs to be
	 Check for duplicate data in your Campus site. If no duplicate data can be found, report the issue to Campus Support. This can be caused by numerous issues. Our code may be attempting to send duplicate records when it should not. The natural key (bolded fields below) may not be unique enough to satisfy Ed-Fi requirements in all cases. 500: Internal Server Error.	Something unexpected happened and no specific error message could be returned.
	 This issue usually occurs when the ODS is having issues. Confirm that there are no issues with the ODS the data is being sent to and then attempt to retry the errored record. Contact Campus Support if 500 errors continue to occur, can be replicated consistently, and the ODS the data is being sent to has no ongoing issues. There is a chance that Campus Ed-Fi code is sending an invalid JSON request resulting in the 500 error. There is a chance that an Ed-Fi Data Standard / API bug is causing the issue. Investigation is needed in these cases as there are many different potential causes.
