Post	When a student has an attendance event on a day marked for instruction • See Appendix for complete set of attendance rules • Do not send records if the Calendar Exclude check box is checked in the calendar the student is enrolled • Do not send records if the School Exclude check box is checked in the calendar the student is enrolled • Do not send a record if the No Show check box is checked
Put	N/A
Delete/Post	When attendance is changed for a student on a given day
Delete	When attendance is changed or removed to no longer meet attendance reporting thresholds
