

NE Ed-Fi Suite 3 API v6.2 Data Standard v4.0: Student Early Learning Program Associations

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Summary

This association relates students participating in an early childhood program to their parents, guardians, or caretakers.

Object Triggering Logic

Action	Business Rule(s)
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Post	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a Programs Fact tab record is created with a Program Name of either 'ECHEADST' or 'ERLYCHLD', and the record Start Date is not after the students enrollment End Date in the current calendar • Report a record based on the student having an overlapping enrollment record in the calendar that the Program Fact record is aligned to • Do not send a student record for an enrollment that is marked as State Exclude or No Show • Do not send a record if enrollment is in a calendar marked as State Exclude • Do not report any Program Facts records without a Start Date • If there are multiple qualifying early childhood Program Records of either 'ECHEADST' or 'ERLYCHLD', report the one with the latest Start Date • If there are multiple qualifying early childhood Program Records of either 'ECHEADST' or 'ERLYCHLD', with the same Start Date, report the one with the highest record ID. • Do not send a record if enrollment is in a School marked as State Exclude • When a new enrollment is created for a student that has a Program Fact record in the calendar in which the student is enrolled • Enrollment start date must be after Program Fact start date • Program Fact end date must be NULL or after enrollment start date • If the student does not have any Programs Fact ERLYCHLD or ECHEADST record (either because it is not active, or it is non-existent) look at the student's active course roster in the current calendar to see if any Early Childhood value is <>NULL in a section • If the student is rostered into a single section with the Early Childhood value <>NULL, report out based on that record • If the student is rostered into more than one section with the Early Childhood value <>NULL, report out based on the section with the most recent Roster Start Date • If the student is rostered into more than one section with the Early Childhood value <>NULL, and they all have the same Roster Start Date, or the Roster Start Dates are all NULL, report out based on the highest sectionID • If the student has an active Programs Fact record and is rostered in a section with the Early Childhood value <>NULL, report the record from the Program Fact record only. • The course must have a State Course code entered to report • When the Program Name or the Start Date values are changed, we must do a Delete of the old record, and a Post of the new record • The start date can change either from the Programs Fact record or the Roster start date being changed • The Program Name can change either from the Programs Name field on the Programs Fact record or the Early Childhood droplist on the section editor
Delete /Post	A DELETE / POST will be performed if the data element being altered is part of the resource's natural key. A PUT will be performed otherwise.
Put	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Update the record if the endDate value in this resource is changed. • Update the record if the roster end date value for the section associated with this record is added or changed.

Delete	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When the Program Name or the Start Date values are changed, we must do a Delete of the old record, and a Post of the new record• The start date can change either from the Programs Fact record or the Roster start date being changed• The Program Name can change either from the Programs Name field on the Programs Fact record or the Early Childhood droplist on the section editor• When all enrollments for a calendar that the Program Fact record is aligned to are deleted.• When the Programs Fact record is deleted.• When the roster record is deleted.• When the Early Childhood value is set to null and saved on the section editor

Error Log

Error Message	Possible Causes / How to Fix
400: Validation of ' RESOURCE ' failed. FIELD is required.	An element of the JSON that is required is missing and needs to be added. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Double check that all bolded data elements below are reporting a valid value and no data elements below are reporting an invalid value.
400: ' RESOURCE ' failed. RESOURCE reference could not be resolved.	A resource that was referenced from a difference resource does not yet exist. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Resync the resource being mentioned in the error, then resync the errored resource. Alternatively, the resource being referenced may be incorrect. This can happen with Schools and the Ed-Fi School ID being used as an example. Double check the referenced values being sent are valid.

<p>403: Authorization denied. The claim does not have any established relationships with the requested resource.</p>	<p>The key/secret being used does not have permission to send a record for the resource / referenced resource.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Double check your API credentials (key/secret). Sometimes specific keys/secrets cannot report specific resources. • The referenced person (student, staff, parent, contact, etc.) has not yet been associated to the key /secret. Resync their "linking" resource (Students Student School Associations, Staffs Staff Education Organization Assignment Associations, etc.) then resync the errored resource. • The referenced person (student, staff, parent, contact, etc.) may not exist in the ODS yet. Resync the "person" resource and the "linking" resource (Students Student School Associations, Staffs Staff Education Organization Assignment Associations, etc.) then resync the errored resource.
<p>404: Failed to delete 'RESOURCE'. Record does not exist.</p>	<p>The attempt to delete a specific Ed-Fi record ID in the ODS failed because it did not exist.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This error can be ignored. The ID was cleared from the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping Report and will not attempt to delete again.
<p>409: A natural key conflict occurred when attempting to create a new resource 'RESOURCE' with a duplicate key.</p>	<p>The Ed-Fi API has a natural key system alongside a standard REST ID system. This error is often protecting against the erroneous creation of a duplicate record in the API. However, it may also indicate that the natural key requirements of the Ed-Fi API have not been satisfied, and the key needs to be modified.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check for duplicate data in your Campus site. If no duplicate data can be found, report the issue to Campus Support. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ This can be caused by numerous issues. Our code may be attempting to send duplicate records when it should not. The natural key (bolded fields below) may not be unique enough to satisfy Ed-Fi requirements in all cases. Most times this error will require a code change to fix.
<p>409: The resource (or a subordinate entity of the resource) cannot be deleted because it is a dependency of the 'RESOURCE' entity.</p>	<p>The resource that the application is attempting to delete is referenced from another entity.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the Delete Tool to delete the referenced resource in the error message. Then retry the delete on the original resource that errored.

500: Internal Server Error.	<p>Something unexpected happened and no specific error message could be returned.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This issue usually occurs when the ODS is having issues. Confirm that there are no issues with the ODS the data is being sent to and then attempt to retry the errored record. • Contact Campus Support if 500 errors continue to occur, can be replicated consistently, and the ODS the data is being sent to has no ongoing issues. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ There is a chance that Campus Ed-Fi code is sending an invalid JSON request resulting in the 500 error. ◦ There is a chance that an Ed-Fi Data Standard / API bug is causing the issue. ◦ Investigation is needed in these cases as there are many different potential causes.

Type/Descriptors - Early Learning Setting Descriptors

Ed-Fi Code Value	Ed-Fi Short Description	Ed-Fi Description
01	NDE Grant Funded Early Childhood Education Program.	Students in state grant funded center- based early childhood education program that has not yet been funded for three consecutive years; not eligible for state aid.
02	Qualified NDE Grant Funded Early Childhood Education Program.	Students in a state grant funded center- based early childhood education program that has been funded for three consecutive years; therefore, four year old students as of July 31 are eligible for state aid.
03	NDE Approved Early Childhood Education Program.	Students in a center-based Rule 11 approved early childhood education program that is not state grant funded and has not been approved for three consecutive years; not eligible for state aid.
04	Qualified NDE Approved Early Childhood Education Program.	Students in a center-based Rule 11 approved early childhood education program that is not state grant funded and has been approved for three consecutive years; therefore, four year old students as of July 31 are eligible for state aid.
05	Early Childhood Birth to Age 3 Endowment Grant Program.	Students age birth to age 3 served in a center-based program or a home visitation program or a combination of the two programs. Applies only to public school districts receiving an Early Childhood Birth to Age 3 Endowment Grant.
06	Home-based Early Childhood Education Program.	Students age birth to kindergarten entrance age served in a home visitation program.
