
What's New

1. Change Tax Code

Broader support has been added to the Change Tax Code process to allow tax codes to be changed on the following:

- Receipts not posted to a debtor.
- Journals with tax code Not Included on BAS (excludes GST, Brought Forward, Opening Balance and where the chart of accounts tax code is not 'Not Included on BAS' including Generated Levies Billed Not Due, Generated Levies Paid In Advance.
- Journals where Account Type is not Equity, Other or Surplus/Deficit or Account Default Tax Code is not any of Not Included on BAS, PAYG Withholding (Wages), PAYG Instalment or PAYG Withholding (No ABN)

This is to assist where GST is activated after transactions have been recorded. For example, the tax code for receipts posted to non-debtor accounts can now be changed.



2. Updates to Search


All Search functions where Legislation can be searched on, have been updated to be a multi-column selector for legislation selection.

Search Creditors, clients can now search for Master chart 0000 by using the Building Number field.


Building Information, selecting an Account Manager can now be set by using the new multi-column box.




Building Information

3. Global Transaction Search – Subgroups

The Global Transaction Search has been updated to support reporting subgroup transactions. This enhancement is now available across both Main and Subgroups within Global and Local Transaction search interfaces.



4. Qld Certificate Changes – 1 August 2025

From August 1st, 2025, the updated Property Law Act comes into effect, and this will mean the removal of the Disclosure Statement from StrataMax and the StrataMax Portal and changes to certificates produced from StrataMax for buildings managed in Queensland. All new certificates will be available from the 1st of August 2025.

What's Better

- Bank Account Setup / Account Maintenance Investment Bank Accounts,
 Investment Interest Accounts and Investment Fee Accounts will now be validated preventing these accounts from being deleted.
- Building Info EFT User ID field length added restriction to only allow users to type in 6 characters
- Building Info Meeting and Voting New field added to capture the number of people required to be present in person at a meeting to achieve a quorum
- Inspections Import Inspection fields can no longer be manually updated.
- Inspections Double clicking on column headings will now work as expected
- Condition filters 'contains' and 'does not contain' have been removed from the Legislation search filter
- Change Code Numbers when updating a code that is attached to an Inspection, system no longer crashes
- DocMax The email Date Sent shown for email documents shows Local or UTC time and did not match the Outlook email that can be opened and viewed
