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# TX Ed-Fi Suite 3 API v7.1 Data Standard v4.0: Special Education Program Reporting Period Attendance

## Summary

The SpecialEducationProgramReportingPeriodAttendance Entity represents the cumulative attendance of a student participating in a special education program.

## Object Triggering

Action	Business Rule
POST	<p>Report attendance for each school the student has a Student School Association record for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reports attendance from associated Attendance Periods <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Date Range of reporting period is the Attendance Start Date through Attendance End Date</li> <li>◦ Exclude any attendance/membership found between Exclude Start Date and Exclude End Date</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Student must have an ADA eligibility record that is active in the reporting range <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ ADA eligibility = to 1/2/3/4/5/6</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Student has an active and locked IEP during the reporting period with a Special Ed Setting mapped to Ed-Fi Code NOT = 40</li> <li>• A change of school within the Attendance Period will cause a record for each school to report</li> <li>• A change in grade level within the Attendance Period will cause a record for each grade level to report</li> <li>• The total days reported for each data element on the record is the total for that specific reporting period <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ If a student has multiple entries and withdrawals in the same grade in the same school on the same instructional track during a specific reporting period, only one record is required and the total days for each data element are reported</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Do not send record if attendance records are associated with an enrollment marked as State Exclude or No Show</li> <li>• Do not send records if attendance records are associated with a Calendar when the Exclude check box is checked</li> <li>• Do not send records if attendance records are associated with a School when the Exclude check box is checked</li> </ul>
PUT	Attendance data is changed within a reported Attendance Period
DELETE	If enrollment that affects the attendance range is deleted

## Attendance Calculation

	Business Rule
1	There is an "Attendance Snapshot Time" set on each Calendar
2	Students who are marked absent in the period that contains the snapshot time are considered absent for the day
3	Students who are marked present in the period that contains the snapshot time are considered present for the day
4	Attendance marks in any other period do not count
5	Students with ADA Eligibility = 2, 5, or 6 count one-half day of absence or presence for each instructional day
6	Students in Grade = EE must have an overlapping IEP to have attendance days included
