

Kennel Assistant In-Person Interview/Observation Guide

NOTE: Use this guide for the In-person interview/Observation. Feel free to skip questions as needed.

Overview: A brief history of the hospital and the open position, interview questions, and ask candidates if they have any questions. Discuss the next steps as needed.

General Questions

- 1. What are the 3 most important things you are looking for in your next opportunity?
- 2. What inspired you to pursue a career in veterinary medicine, and how did you become a kennel attendant?
- 3. How many years of experience do you have working in a veterinary practice, and what roles have you held?
- 4. Can you describe your experience caring for animals in a veterinary setting, including feeding, watering, exercising, and administering medications?
- 5. What are some of the most important skills and qualities you bring to the veterinary team as a kennel attendant?
- 6. How do you ensure that the animals in the kennel receive the best possible care and attention, and how do you communicate with the veterinary team to achieve this goal?
- 7. Can you describe your experience with animal behavior and handling and how you ensure the safety of both the animals and yourself?
- 8. How do you handle difficult or aggressive animals, and what steps do you take to ensure their well-being and the safety of others?
- 9. Can you tell me about a time when you went above and beyond your duties to provide excellent care for an animal and what you learned from the experience?
- 10. How do you ensure the kennel area is clean and well-maintained, and how do you manage laundry and waste disposal?
- 11. Can you describe your experience with inventory management, including ordering and stocking supplies and equipment?
- 12. How do you handle confidential or sensitive information, such as client medical records or animal health information?



- 13. Can you describe your experience with electronic medical records and animal information management and how you ensure their accuracy and confidentiality?
- 14. How do you stay current on the latest animal care and welfare developments and continue to improve your knowledge and skills?
- 15. Can you describe a time when you had to handle a difficult or emotional situation involving an animal or a client and how you managed the situation?
- 16. What are your long-term career goals as a kennel attendant, and how do you plan to achieve them?
