

Veterinary Assistant In-Person Interview/Observation Guide

NOTE: Use this guide for the In-person interview/Observation. Feel free to skip questions as needed.

Overview: A brief history of the hospital and the open position, interview questions, and ask candidates if they have any questions. Discuss the next steps as needed.

General Questions

- 1. What are the 3 most important things you seek in your next career opportunity?
- 2. What made you decide to pursue a career in veterinary medicine?
- 3. What experience do you have working with animals?
- 4. Can you tell me about a time when you went above and beyond for an animal in your care?
- 5. How do you handle difficult or aggressive animals?
- 6. Have you ever assisted in a surgery before? If so, what was your role, and what did you learn?
- 7. How do you prioritize and manage tasks when multiple things happen simultaneously in the clinic?
- 8. What is your experience with animal restraint techniques?
- 9. What do you think are the most important qualities for a veterinary assistant to possess?
- 10. Can you describe your experience with administering medication to animals?
- 11. What do you do to ensure the clinic is always clean and organized?
- 12. How do you communicate with clients when assisting in appointments or procedures?
- 13. Have you ever dealt with an emergency at the clinic? If so, can you describe what happened and how you responded?
- 14. What do you think sets you apart from other veterinary assistants?
- 15. Can you describe a time when you had to work with a difficult coworker or client and how you handled the situation?
- 16. How do you stay current on the latest veterinary medicine and technology developments?
