### Summary, Scope, and Purpose

The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) approves Career and Technical Education Programs (CTE) that meet teacher licensing and other criteria. These programs are eligible to access federal Carl D. Perkins funds. Districts that accept these federal dollars must report enrollment and student proficiency for CTE courses and programs to the department.

R1	A record will be created for each Student within the Calendar(s) selected on the Extract Editor that are rostered into a Course with a value for Perkins Code and Perkins Program Code <b>AND</b> have a Grade entered in that Course for a Grading Task that is marked as State Reported.  • While the Grading Task being marked as Final is <b>NOT</b> required for reporting a record, it is highly recommended as the Final checkbox drives logic on multiple data elements such as GradeReceived.
R1. BR1	A record will be generated for each unique Student-School-Course combination.
R1. BR2	<ul> <li>The following act as excludes:</li> <li>Course State Exclude</li> <li>Cross Site Data</li> <li>Will only be excluded when Cross Site Exclude is checked on the Extract Editor.</li> </ul>
R2	The report can be run against a district's active year as well as any prior year.
