### Reporting Population and Business Rules

#	Requirement
R1	Reports Student participation days
R1. BR1	One line per student; Sum all Program 194 records for the school year. All students with an active Extended Learning Opportunities Program report, hours are zero if they never attended.
R2	Students do not have to be enrolled on the Reporting Date, just at some time during the year.
R3	Do not report students with State Exclude checked on their enrollment, or in a grade level marked as State Exclude, or in a calendar marked as State Exclude.
R4	Do not report No Show students.
R5	Students with Service Type=N should not report.
