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## WI Ed-Fi Suite 3 API v7.3 Data Standard v5.2: Student Section Associations

### Summary

This association indicates the course sections to which a student is assigned

### Object Triggering

Action	Business Rule(s)
Post	<p>When a student is scheduled into a course section</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Report if student section has a Grading Task or Standard with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>State Reported = selected</li> <li>Exclude from Ed-Fi = deselected</li> </ul> </li> <li>Report a record based on the Term Mask of the state reported Grading Task <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If Roster End Date is null, use the term mask to determine the term to report</li> <li>If Roster End Date is not null, use the term the endDate falls within to report</li> </ul> </li> <li>If Ed-Fi Configuration Profile = Choice + Private Opt In or Choice Only, do not send any records</li> <li>Report from any enrollment determining a record. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the student has multiple qualifying enrollments in the same school, report a record for each unique start date.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Do not send if Student Section Association does not have an overlapping Student School Association</li> <li>Do not send a record based on an enrollment that is marked as State Exclude, No Show, or WISE Exclude</li> <li>Do not send a record based on an enrollment is in a calendar marked as State Exclude or Summer School</li> <li>Report records only if the student's State Enrollment Type = Primary or Coursework Only</li> </ul>

Delete/Post	When student's roster start date is changed

Delete	<p>When a student is deleted from a course section</p> <p>Delete any future records if the student is given a roster end date for the course</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Roster End Date must be before Term Start date of future records</li></ul> <p>If a student's State Enrollment type is changed from Primary or Coursework and saved</p>
