

AZ Ed-Fi Suite v7.3, Data Standard v5.2: Student Special Education Program Associations (SY 25-26)

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Summary

This association represents the special education program(s) that a student participates in or receives services from. The association is an extension of the StudentProgramAssociation particular for special education programs.

This is the case for Title 1, Food Service, etc. If you are receiving this error, it is recommended to contact AzEDS to verify that the program exists for your district. • Alternative Cause: The programName or programTypeDescriptor we are reporting was changed from one school year to another. We are currently sending the incorrect value. This will require a development change, and it is recommended to contact Campus Support if you believe this is the issue.
<p>500: Internal Server Error.</p>	<p>Something unexpected happened and no specific error message could be returned.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This issue usually occurs when the ODS is having issues.
