

VA Ed-Fi Suite v3.6.2, Data Standard v4.0: Student Education Organization Associations

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Summary

This association represents student information that is specific to a student's relationship with an Education Organization.

Error Message	Possible Causes / How to Fix

Most times this error will require a code change to fix. 500: Internal Server Error.	Something unexpected happened and no specific error message could be returned.
	 This issue usually occurs when the ODS is having issues. Confirm that there are no issues with the ODS the data is being sent to and then attempt to retry the errored record. Contact Campus Support if 500 errors continue to occur, can be replicated consistently, and the ODS the data is being sent to has no ongoing issues. There is a chance that Campus Ed-Fi code is sending an invalid JSON request resulting in the 500 error. There is a chance that an Ed-Fi Data Standard / API bug is causing the issue. Investigation is needed in these cases as there are many different potential causes.
