

Caller Sheet and Calling Card Instructions

CALLER SHEET

- The caller sheet lists every dog included in the bingo game. Under each dog, there are **5 boxes**.

How to use it:

- When you call a dog, **mark an X** in one box under that dog's name/picture.
- Each box represents **one full game**, allowing you to track up to **5 games**.
- After finishing a game, **move to the next column of boxes** for the next round.
- Make sure to **call the dogs in a different order each game** so each round is unique.

CALLING CARDS

- The calling cards allow you to call dogs **randomly**, just like traditional Bingo.

How to prepare the cards:

- Cut along the **dotted lines** to separate each card.
- Shuffle all cards together.
- Place them in a bowl, bag, or stack.

How to use the cards during play:

- Draw one card at a time.
- Announce the dog shown on the card.
- Set the card aside so it doesn't get reused during the same round.

For a new game:

- Shuffle all cards again

Print the cards on **cardstock** for longer durability (optional but recommended).

Caller Sheet

Mark an X in one box each time you call that dog. Each dog has 5 boxes so the caller can track calls for up to 5 games. Make sure to call the dogs in a different order each game.
