Activity Scholarship Info Sheet

The Hous Foundation is a 501c3 that helps families pay for the costs of participation in non-school activities for youth.

Application

- A parent or guardian must apply for children in their care.
- Scholarship will help to cover the following costs:
 - Sports and recreation programs
 - Music, art, dance, or theater classes
 - Coding, STEM, and learning programs
 - Camps, clubs, and similar activities
- Scholarship will not cover the following costs
 - School tuition or required tutoring
 - Personal items not needed for the activity
 - Cash payments to families
- Applications are reviewed monthly. Applications need to be completed by the 14th of the month for review.
- Scholarship amounts range based on number of applicants and funding available. Each youth can receive up to \$500 per calendar year.
- Families with multiple children are eligible to apply for each child.
- No specific income level is required.

Approval and Payment

- Applications are reviewed on the 15th of every month.
- Each application is reviewed by 2 people at the Hous Foundation.
- Funding amounts are based on the cost of activity and available funding.
- Notifications will be made to applicants by the 21st of the month.
- Payments are made directly to the organization not the families.
 - Payments will be made via check on the 30th of the month.
 - Payments will be made in a lump sum.
 - A list of applicants, approved amount and parent/guardian who applied will be sent to CRPD designated staff 3 days after the families have been notified.

Funding Notes

- First-time applicants are prioritized when reviewing applications.
- Application for scholarship does not guarantee funding. Funding is limited, not all applications will be approved.
