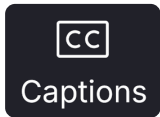


[Blackboard Ally \(Diagnostic Tool\)](#)

Integrated directly into D2L Brightspace, Ally is a diagnostic tool, not a compliance tool. It scans course content to gauge accessibility, provides faculty with tips for improvement, and automatically generates alternative file formats for students.



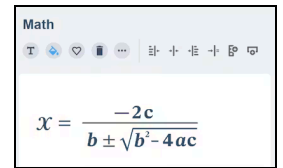
[YuJa Lumina \(Video Platform\)](#)



YuJa Lumina generates starting-point captions and transcripts for video and audio materials. Faculty can then easily edit these for accuracy to ensure everyone can access media content.

[Equatio, for Math & Science](#)

By generating alt text for equations, Equatio supports low-vision, visually impaired, and blind students. Faculty and students can also speak math or write by hand using touch or mouse, and Equatio converts it into digital math.
